TASTING NOTES

The 2016 American Vintage red blend is deep ruby red in the glass. Greeting you with notes of baked boysenberry, bramble, black tea and cedar on the nose, you are enticed to taste this elixir. On the palate, the wine is balanced and full-bodied with notes of preserved raspberry with baking spices, dusty soil, flowers and a hint of Herbes de Provence. The clean finish has bright acidity and has a plush and long texture as the flavors linger.
